CALL FOR PAPERS

The manuscripts should be prepared using double line spacing, Times New Roman and font size 12 in Microsoft word. There should be consistency in the use of either British or American English spelling. Harvard style referencing should be used,.

ORGANIZATION OF MANUSCRIPT

The manuscript should be divided into clearly-defined and numbered sections as follows: Introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusion and recommendation and references. Subsections should be numbered 1.1, then 1.1.1, 1.1.2 then 1.2. The abstract should not be included in section numbering. The following details are expected:

TITLE: Appropriate, informative and concise.

AUTHORS: Names and contact addresses of all the authors are to be stated. The corresponding author should include phone number and e-mail address.

ABSTRACT: A concise and factual abstract is required. The abstract should state briefly the purpose of the research, the principal results and major calculations. The abstract should not be more than 250 words.

KEYWORDS: Should not be more than five (5) words.

INTRODUCTION: This includes the objectives of the work and adequate background.

MATERIALS AND METHODS: Provide sufficient details to allow the work to be reproduced.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION: Result should be clear and concise. Discussion should explore the significance of the results of the work and not repeat them.

CONCLUSIONS: The conclusions are the fallout from the results.

REFERENCES: All sources mentioned in the text should be referenced and vice versa

FIGURES AND TABLES: Figures and Tables should be presented after reference list. Figures should be numbered and consecutively in accordance with their appearance in the text. Ensure that each illustration has a caption. Tables should be numbered consecutively in accordance with their appearance in the text. Avoid horizontal line in the tables.
